## EX – GENERAL MANAGER OF THE SEWERAGE BOARD OF NICOSIA HAS BEEN ACQUITTED NOT GUILTY

The District Court of Nicosia gave its judgment to the sensational trial of Christodoulos Yiallouros ex- General Manager of the Sewerage Board of Nicosia.

Mr. Yiallouros was charged that he forged and circulated a certificate presenting him as chartered certified accountant of the United Kingdom. Also, presenting himself as chartered certified accountant obtained employment at the Sewerage Board of Nicosia and subsequently he was promoted to the post of the General Manager. The Republic, in prosecuting Mr. Yiallouros, sought the return of his total earnings in the Sewerage Board of Nicosia amounting to £570,000. Finally, the accused was charged with the accusation that he refused to conform in a written order of the police examiners to present his certificate under discussion.

The District Judge Mr. Yiapanas found Mr. Yiallouros not guilty and acquitted him from all the charges. The Judge noted that there was not a shred of evidence on which to base legally the offence of forgery. Also, the Court ruled that the allegation that Yiallouros's employment had been obtained under false pretences had not been substantiated. Furthermore, the Judge deemed that, according to the law, the onus of presenting documents could not lie with the accused since this would run contrary to the right of no self – discrimination.

The accused was represented by the Lawyers Menelaos Kyprianou of the Law Office of Michalakis Kyprianou & Co and Christakis Christaki of the Law Office of A.S. Angelides & Co.

# **Ex-director** acquitted

THE FORMER Director General of the Nicosia Sewerage Board (NSB) Christodoulos Yiallouros has been acquitted by the Nicosia District Court of forging a chartered accountant's qualification in order to obtain employment.

The Judge said there was not a shred of evidence on which to base legally the offence of forgery.

He also ruled that the allegation that Yiallouros's employment had been obtained under false pretences had not been substantiated. Furthermore, the judge noted that, according to the law, the onus of presenting documents could not lie with the accused since this would run contrary to the right of non self-discrimination.

In prosecuting Yiallouros, the Republic sought the return of his total earnings in the NSB, amounting to £570,000.
